I love that the same sentiment still applies. In fact, ESSE has been hand building their cast-iron cookers here in the UK since 1854. Its Mrs Sam cooker was even relied upon by Ernest Shackleton during his Antarctic Expeditions, feeding 30 or so mouths in ~45°C conditions without ever letting him down. That's some customer recommendation!

Nowadays, ESSE's stoves come in more than 20 colours and can be fuelled by wood, gas, oil or electricity. There are even models with induction hobs. My favourite is the stunning Teal Green Electric two-oven stove above, which I would call Steve (Steve the Stove), as I think a stove is part of the family and should therefore have a name. NOT because I'm a bit barmy, OK, maybe that, too. HomeShoppingSpy prefers the compact Plus I wood burner, who she thinks looks like an 'Eric'. Obviously.

For ESSE consumer PR, I have secured national coverage in a large number of well-known magazine titles.
